Polyurethanes: created in nearly 1,000 locations in the U.S., directly generating **\$28.6 billion** in output and **48,800 jobs**

Polyurethanes Support Economic Growth:

In total, about **230,000 jobs** and **\$74.3 billion** in output

Polyurethanes generate **\$280.7 billion** in output and employ more than **1 million** workers in other industries

Polyurethanes Generate Jobs:



An additional **\$45.7 billion** in economic output and nearly **180,000 jobs** in related industries

Polyurethanes Multiplier Effect:



Industry generates upstream jobs in direct supplier industries and other employment
